

Community Emergency Response Management

Types of Emergencies that could be experience by the site:

- Fires
- Accidental product or fuel spills.
- Natural Hazards – High winds, floods or earthquakes.

Community Emergency Response

- In normal circumstances you should not need to do anything in the event of an emergency as it will be controlled by site personnel and where required by the emergency services. The police will notify you if there is a need to evacuate.
- **During an Emergency:**
 - Go indoors immediately
 - Close external doors and windows
 - Switch of any air conditioners or exhaust fans
 - Remain indoors until you receive instructions from emergency services
 - Tune into the radio or television and listen for instructions and updates.
 - Telephones should only be used in emergencies; this ensures lines are free for emergency services.
- **After an emergency:** when an “all clear” has been given, restore ventilation and follow instructions given by the emergency services.

Site Emergency Procedure:

Our emergency alarm is a continuous audible alarm throughout the plant.

Environmental or local emergencies are announced over the site public address system.

All personnel on site are trained in first aid, fire response and environmental compliance. The site is able to deal with any situation through procedures and a trained emergency response team that runs annual drills to test are readiness and response to emergencies.
